Main activities



Increase availability of suitable fodder:

- analisys on fodder components
- training on animal nutrition and fodder production
- distribution of seeds and hay



- training on breeding techniques and Al services
- provision of Al insemination services
- development of ICT extension platform



Access to credit for micro enterprises:

- training on finance management
- linking farmers to micro finance institutions



Increase of the production of **energy from renewable**:

sources and CO2 reduction

- training on clean energy and biogas production
- installation of 30 biogas system
- planting of 100.000 trees



Development of an efficient system of use of **water**

- training on water conservation and irrigation techniques
